Dear Mr. Kelterborn:


The Michigan Department of Attorney General and the Michigan Department of Environmental Quality (MDEQ) (collectively the State) are in receipt of the Termination Notice submitted by CMS Land Company and CMS Capital, LLC (collectively CMS) pursuant to Paragraphs 31.2 and 31.3 of the Agreement. The Termination Notice was dated July 17, 2012.

The State has reviewed the Termination Notice, 2012 PA 190 (effective June 20, 2012), and the MDEQ's Policy and Procedure for Evaluating Mercury in Groundwater Plumes Relative to the Groundwater Surface Water Interface Pursuant to Part 201 (effective June 20, 2012) (MDEQ Policy 09-014). The State concurs that 2012 PA 190 satisfies the triggering event described in Paragraph 31.2(a) for terminating certain obligations under the Agreement. Additionally, the State concurs that MDEQ Policy 09-014 satisfies the triggering event described in 31.2(b) for terminating certain obligations under the Agreement.

In accordance with Paragraph 31.2, the State concurs that CMS's obligations under Paragraphs 7.5, 7.6, 7.7, 7.8, 7.15, 7.17, 7.18, and Attachments K and L have terminated. CMS is now required to complete the Additional Obligations identified in Paragraph 7.27.
